NOW THIS AGREEMENT WITNESTH THAT

1. CONTRACT PERIOD

This AGREEMENT shall be in force for a period of One year w.e.f. 01.02.2022 to 31.01.2024 and may be renewed further on such terms and conditions as may be

2. EXTENT OF COVERAGE

MANPOWER

The second party will:

- 4.2. A list of prospective candidates required of GDA'S /Housekeepers will be provided along with the bio data to the Housekeeping Manager. The Housekeeping Manager shall scrutinized the bio data and interview the candidates candidates who qualify in the interview will be deployed after getting concurrence of the HRD.
